## 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Women's Golf Scramble

On June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Central Michigan District Health Department (CMDHD) and Pleasant Hills Golf Club held the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Women's Scramble to benefit the CMDHD Breast and Cervical Cancer Endowment Fund. This fund was created to provide breast and cervical cancer education and financial assistance for diagnostic testing for eligible women in CMDHD's Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program. A total of thirty-nine 3-women teams participated in the outing. More than \$3,500 was raised for the fund through this year's event.

Michigan's Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program provide free annual breast and cervical cancer screenings and diagnostic services to eligible women across the state. To be eligible for the program, a woman must be between age 40 and 64, have no insurance, and meet income requirements. Women who are diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer through the program may be eligible for Medicaid for their treatment.
